## Orchestra's live at Cincinnati Ballet

Cincinnati Ballet says there will be live music for its next two productions, "Cinderella," Feb. 12-14, and the world premiere of Mozart's Requiem, March 26-27, both featuring the Cincinnati Ballet Orchestra conducted by Carmon DeLeone.

Mozart's Requiem, a world premiere choreographed by Adam Houghland, will also include the Xavier Concert Choir.

The full-length fairy tale ballet "Cinderella" is choreographed by Ballet Artistic Director and CEO Victoria Morgan. It has all the classic elements: underappreciated daughter, wicked stepmother and stepsisters, fairy godmother and prince. Next season, three of the Ballet's six concerts will feature live music performed by the Cincinnati Symphony Orchestra through the Louise Nippert Musical Arts fund, with a contribution estimated to be \$200,000 a year.

The Ballet also reports that contributions are up, surpassing the early contingency goal in January. Enrollment in children's classes is up to 90 percent capacity.
